A.G.M. SEPTEMBER POSITION DESCRIPTION

DIRECTOR:

*To review & maintain the standard & direction of the Chapter & the Committee

*To resolve/arbitrate disputes & grievances

*To show by example that motorcycling is an honourable & favourable pastime.

*To maintain the safety of Chapter records

*To oversee Chapter meetings & uphold the HOG charter & its bylaws

The Director is the "Meeter and Greeter" & the first point of contact for all outsiders. i.e. other Chapters, charities, businesses & the general public.

The Director should have 10 hours per week of free time.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR:

*To assist the Director in his/her duties *Plan Chapter activities together with the Director. Road Captains & Activities Officer The Assistant Director should have 5-10 hours per week of free time.

**The administration duties of the Chapter are carried out by the Secretary & the Treasurer. These are the housekeeping duties of the Chapter & the most demanding. Both of these officers need 4-5 hours per week keeping records up to date & notifying relevant authorities.

SECRETARY:

*Maintaining & updating membership records

*Maintaining & updating Chapter records (minutes, correspondence, incorporation etc.)

*Receiving & sending all written correspondence

*Responsible for the administrative needs of the Chapter

*Ensures all members are also members of HOG International

*Advising HOG International & other chapters of the current

list of Officers *Official HOG reports

TREASURER:

*Maintenance & updating of Chapter financial records including memberships, social events, advertising, insurances, raffles, bank fees, charity donations, patches & Tshirt sales *Preparation of annual financial statements for the Secretary

ROAD CAPTAIN:

*To liaise, submit for approval, advertise & co-ordinate all Cape York Chapter HOG rides etc. *Plan rides prior to submission for approval i.e. service stations, road hazards, scenic routes etc. *Report on rides past & future in the newsletter The Road Captain should have approximately 5 hours of free time per week.

ACTIVITIES OFFICER:

*To liaise, submit for approval, advertise & co-ordinate motorcycling social activities of interest to the members i.e. inter-chapter events, gymkhanas, BBQ.s. rallies with other clubs, poker runs...
*Oversee the administration of Chapter events
The Activities officer should have about 5 hours of free time

LADIES OF HARLEY OFFICER:

*To encourage women to take part in Chapter Activities, whether they ride of not.

SAFETY OFFICER:

*Provide information to the members on all aspects of safe riding i.e. first aid, rider training programs, mechanical tips, interesting information about motorcycle riding.

PHOTOGRAPHER:

*Maintain a photographic history of club events

HISTORIAN:

*Maintain a written account of club events (in conjunction with the Photographer)





RIDE RULES

- Use one lane of a multi-lane highway.
- Ride as a group both to and from our destination.
- Bikes to be parked in an orderly formation, and departure to be singular formation after the Road Captain.
- Have fun but remember, the eyes of the public are on us, so conduct yourself in an appropriate manner.
